Does France have solar power?

Only in 2008 did France see a significant increase in solar PV installations. From a low point in 2009 to a high point in 2011, PV capacity nearly tenfold. Solar power in France grew steadily in 2015, reaching a total photovoltaic capacity of 6.6 gigawatts by the end of the year, delivering 6.7 Terawatt hours of electricity.

How much solar power will France have in 2035?

EDF, a state-owned corporation, announced in 2018 to invest EUR25 billion in solar power generation and adopt green electricity prices, with the goal of "increasing 30 gigawatts of solar capacity in France between 2020 and 2035. Solar power capacity is expected to grow, with roughly 18-20 GW expected to be constructed by 2023.
